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1. Introduction

India is home to over 30% of almost 385 million children living in extreme poverty, the highest in south Asia, according to a new report by World Bank Group and Unicef. **1 in 4** children of school-going age is out of school in our country – 99 million children in total have dropped out of school (*Census 2011*). Out of every 100 children, only 32 children finish their school education age-appropriately and only 2% of the schools offer complete school education from Class 1 to Class 12 [*District Information System for Education (DISE) 2014-15*]

Most of these children are trapped in a cycle of deprivation: As young adults, they're unlikely to be in school or working, and their children will likely follow a similar path, but a small percentage manage to escape their circumstances. There are 10.13 million child labourers between ages of 5-14 years and also India has 33 million working children between the ages of 5-18 years. In parts of the country, more than half the child population is engaged in labour (*Census 2011*). Fear of failure in examinations in the second highest cause of suicides in children (*Accidental Deaths and Suicides in India ADSI 2014*).

India has more than 45 lakh girls under 15 years of age who are married with children. Out of these, 70% of the girls have 2 children. 42% of married women in India were married as children. 1 in every 3 child brides in the world is a girl in India. [*District Information System for Education (DISE) 3*]

Education is one of the most effective agents of change in society. When a child is able to go to school today, he or she sets off a cycle of positive change. But, thousands of children in India lack access to education and can't even write their own names. Moreover, underprivileged children between the ages of 11 to 14 years are hugely vulnerable to dropping out of schools. An educated child stays away from an early marriage and is empowered to stand up against exploitation. As children grow, they are able to make better choices for themselves and influence the communities they live in. This transforms their present life and ensures a secure future for them.

2. Why to tell Hamara School's students' success stories?
